

Former bureaucrat died



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In a most shocking incident, a former bureaucrat died after he slipped from a moving [train](#) in West Bengal on [Saturday](#).

The incident took place near Shamuktala station in the neighbouring state where retired [Water](#) Resources Department secretary Dilip Kumar [Chetia](#) was [killed](#) after he fell from the Delhi-bound [Rajdhani](#) Express.

According to eyewitness, [Chetia](#) fell from the [train](#) as he was standing at the door of the moving [train](#).

His son Hrisiraj [Chetia](#) identified the [body](#) on [Sunday](#) at the Alipurduar District Hospital where the [body](#) was taken for post mortem.

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
