

Free to move review appeal in court



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Caught in NRC confusion, Opposition [leader](#) in the Assam Assembly Debobrata Saikia said that the NRC authority is free to appeal to the court to review the decision.

Talking to reporters in Dispur on Wednesday, Saikia said the court might review it [as](#) the process gathered momentum.

Many political [leaders](#) who spoke to Assam Times on the condition of anonymity said that NRC might not be completed with the next two or three years if these [documents](#) are rejected.

The Gauhati High Court on Tuesday rejected these certificates saying that if a panchayat secretary is allowed to issue such certificates the tribunals might reject its merit.

“If the court or a tribunal detects a certificate holder [as](#) immigrant who will run the risk,” said the court. The court maintained that these certificate could be used [as](#) a shelter for the immigrants to stay in the [state](#).

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
