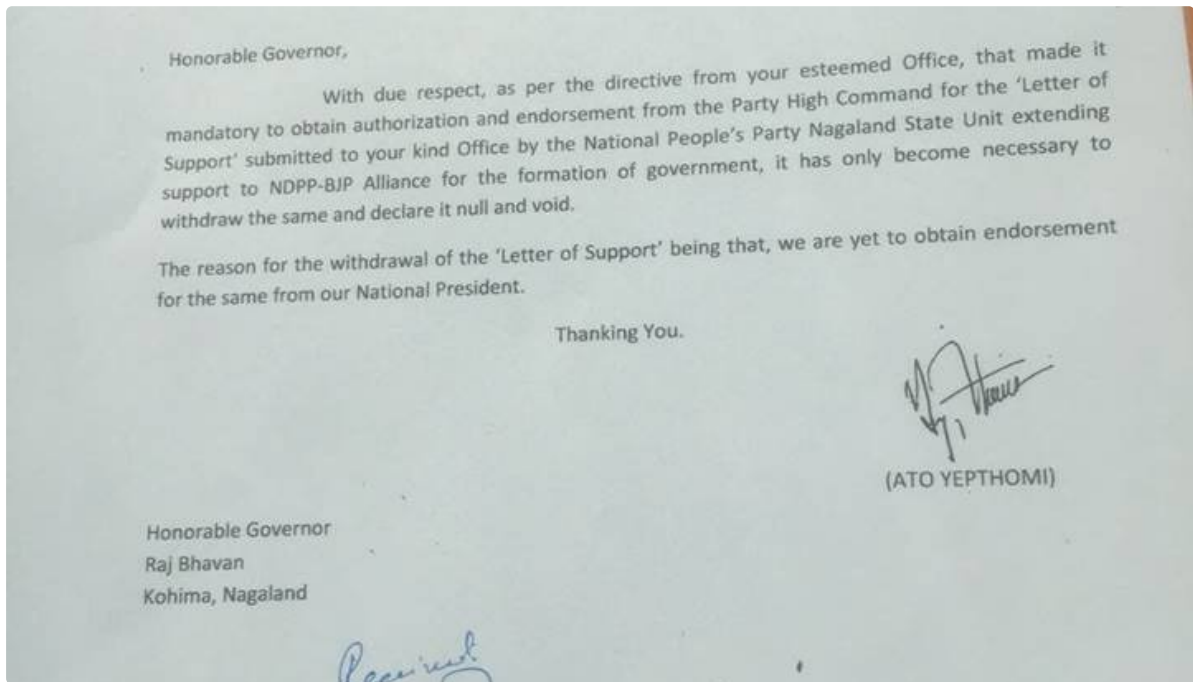


Fresh trouble for Rio as NPP withdraws support
