

Gauhati HC exempts ULFA cadre from NSA

The Gauhati High Court on Tuesday ordered exemption of ULFA leader Dibakor Moran from the National Security Act. A division bench of the Court comprising Chief Justice J Chalmeswar and Justice Ashok Putsangbash was hearing a petition filed by Maran's family members challenging the arrest of Dibakor under the NSA.
