

GMCH allays kala azar fear



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The fears of kala azars that gripped the people across the state have been allayed by the Guwhati Medical College Hospital authorities on Thursday. According to information, the confirmation was followed by the report of test conducted on eleven people which have proved negative. These people have been rushed to the Guwahti medical College Hospital very recently. The doctors feared it to be the case of kala azars in view of the symptoms which has clear resemblance of this fatal disease. These people who have been rushed to the hospital including two children from Panikhaity area in the outskirts of the city. All but a woman patient have fled from the hospital while they were undergoing treatment at the GMCH. The hospital authorities have already lodged a complaint with the police citing their names and address.
