

Gogoi blames Centre for adequate forces



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Assam Chief Minister Tarun Gogoi has partially blamed the Centre for providing him with inadequate security forces to bring the situation under control. Addressing a press conference in Guwahati on Friday, Gogoi said that a reduction in Central forces has put him in a fix.

Gogoi also said that his resignation over the issue was not going to help reduce the tension. "Had there been full forces there, the situation could have been controlled," he said. Gogoi made it clear that he was not making it a vote bank politics. He said, "I do not need a single vote of the illegal migrants."
