

Gogoi still enjoys Sonia support



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A section of [AICC](#) leaders is understood to have devised a mechanism to [end dissidence](#) in [CLP](#) by changing chief minister. They are averse to allow Tarun [Gogoi](#) to continue as chief minister.

But top [AICC](#) sources told this correspondent that there is hardly any chance for change in chief minister. The [meeting](#) slated for June 23 in New Delhi is expected to discuss the [overall](#) party affairs two years ahead of the assembly [polls](#).

[Sonia](#) Gandhi is believed to have confirmed [Gogoi](#) as chief minister till the 2016 assembly [polls](#). If that's all, [Gogoi](#) will be able to continue as chief minister who is prepared to [reshuffle](#) his [cabinet](#) after June 23.

To be chaired by vice president [Rahul](#) Gandhi, the [meeting](#) is expected to discuss the strategies for the 2016 assembly [polls](#) in presence of chief minister Tarun [Gogoi](#) and [APCC](#) president Bhubneswar Kalita along with [AICC](#) leaders Ahmed Patel, Dr CP Joshi, Ghulam Nabi [Azad](#) and Motilal Vhora and the newly elected MPs.

Notably, [AICC](#) leaders on [Thursday](#) gave hint of change in [Assam](#) chief minister after the crucial [meeting](#) slated for June 23.

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
