

Gogoi takes on Modi on land deal



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Chief minister Tarun Gogoi has come down heavily on prime minister Narendra Modi a day after the union cabinet dropped Assam from the purview of the land swap [deal](#) with Bangladesh.

Addressing a press conference in Dispur, Gogoi said the decision would harm the state.
