

Gogoi tears apart Modi on B'deshi



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Chief Minister Tarun Gogoi on Tuesday sharpened attack on Prime Minister Narendra Modi alleging U turn in Bangladeshi and land [deal](#) issues.

Participating in a debate in the day two of the assembly's winter session, Gogoi criticized Modi for his poll promises that the [Bangladeshi infiltrators](#) would have to leave Assam after May 16.

He further attacked Modi for 'U-turn' over Land Boundary Agreement with Bangladesh. He said, "BJP members went to the border, hoisted the tri-colour and said no portion of Assam land would be given to Bangladesh. Now they are supporting the agreement and are saying that I told the truth."

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
