

Gohain gets railway



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Rajen Gohain has been given railway [ministry](#) hours after the Nagaon MP took oath [as](#) minister of [state](#) on Tuesday. Prime Minister [Narendra Modi](#) allocated the portfolio to the senior BJP [leader](#) fetching a ray of hope for the north eastern region.
