

Gold seized in Guwahati again



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GUWAHATI: Guwahati, the gateway to the north eastern region has become a safe route for gold smuggling these days.

Security forces attached to the Northeast Frontier Railway seized twelve pieces of gold worth Rs 70 lakh from a [New Delhi](#) bound train on Friday.

Acting on a tip off, a team of railway police raided two passengers from the Rajdhani Express just before it departing the city in the morning and seized the gold biscuits brought from [Dimapur](#).
