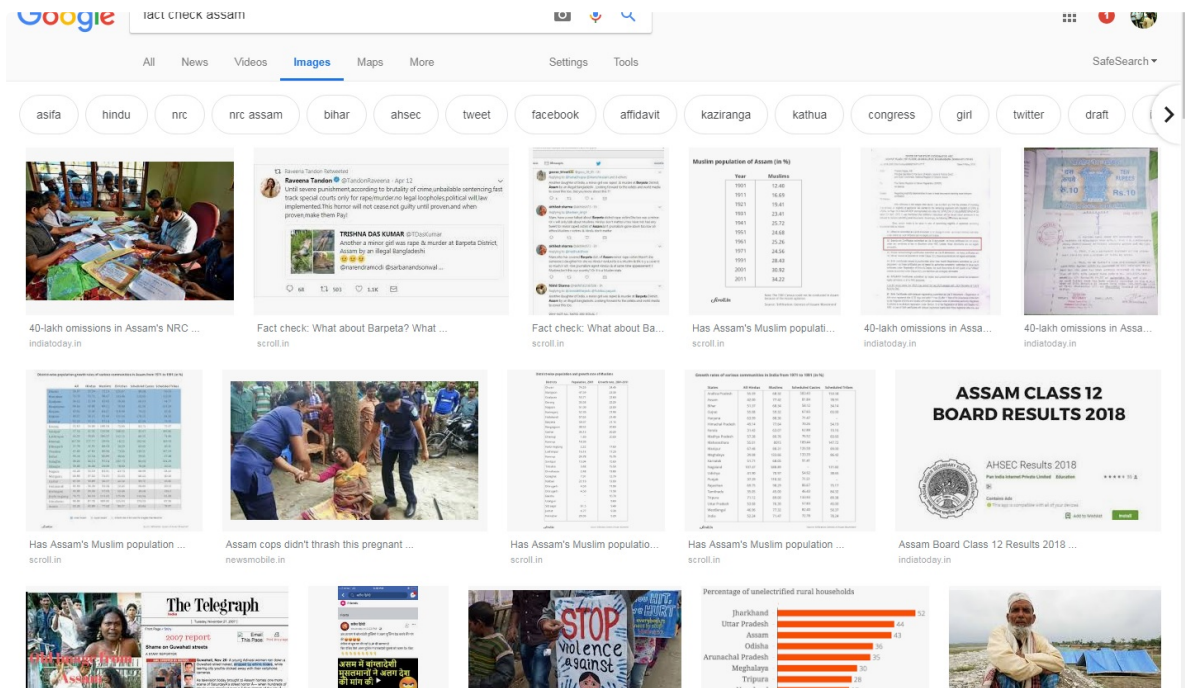


# Google Fact-checking Workshop
