

Governor condemns terrorist attack on security forces



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Assam Governor Prof. Jagdish Mukhi condemned the deadly suicide attack on security forces in Kashmir's Pulwama which left many dead and scores of others injured.

In a statement here today, Prof. Mukhi said that the suicide bomber ramming a car packed with explosives into a CRPF convoy on the Jammu-Srinagar highway though an attack on the security, the country stands united to tackle any exigency.
