

Govind confesses to have killed Sweta



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The sensation murder of Sweta Agarwalla is no longer a mystery now. The person that took her life was none other than Govind Singhal who forcibly took the KC [Das](#) Commerce College girl to his house as she was on her way back to her house in the afternoon.

During police interrogation Govind, a colleague intern of a firm confessed to have hit her on the [wall](#) before she died. Then he along with his mother and sister poured kerosene on her body to destroy evidence and planned to depart the city.

Govind was angry with her when she has been repeatedly refusing to be with him.

On the other hand, many organizations and individuals have mounted pressure on the authority to ensure capital punishment of Govind, his mother and sister for committing the double crime.

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NAZIRA, September 27, 2026 — Tension continues to prevail in Nazira, particularly in the Santak-Bihubar area, following the killing of Biman Barua, president of the Rangajan Yuva Samaj and a youth social worker, on September 18 under Bihubar Police Station.

Following the killing, local residents have been demanding stringent punishment for the alleged masterminds, Ravindra Singh alias Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan, besides seeking demolition of Vicky Singh's residence.

Meanwhile, Sivasagar district police have taken Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan into custody and are questioning them at the district headquarters police station in connection with the murder case and allegations of drug-related activities.

According to police sources, the two allegedly told investigators during questioning that drugs were brought from Dimapur and Nagaland and stored at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister in Nazira town. The drugs were allegedly supplied from the house to users in different parts of Nazira and Sivasagar.

Based on the information allegedly obtained during the questioning, a joint team of Bihubar Police and Nazira Model Police Station conducted a raid at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister, Rinki Singh Bora, in Ward No. 6 of Nazira town on Saturday morning.

Police detained Rinki Singh Bora and are reportedly questioning her in connection with the alleged storage and distribution of drugs.

The investigation into the murder of Biman Barua and the alleged drug network is continuing.
