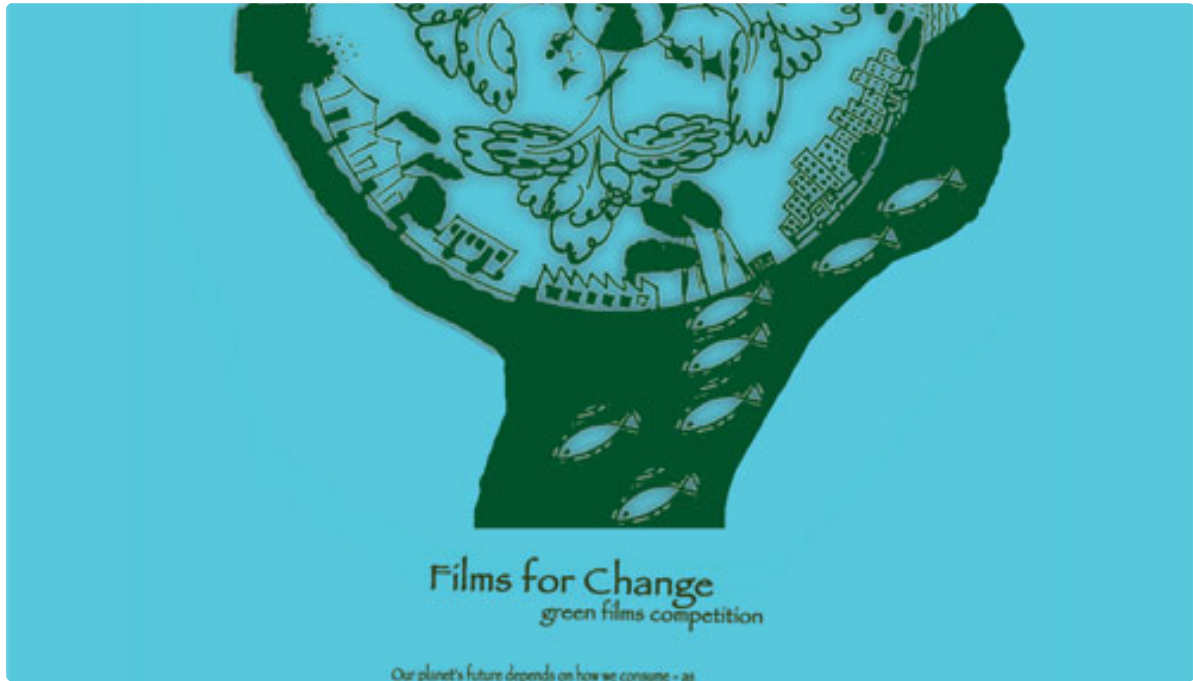


Green film competition launched

The festival is accepting the entries till 15th December 2014. The on line competition that attempts to reach out to the youngsters has three categories i.e. The Polluting Cities, E-waste and The Change Makers. Best film in each category would be awarded with mobile phone camera.

Notably, the competition is part of the bigger films for change programme, that reached thousands of youngsters across country.
