

Gupta laid to rest



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[Journalist](#) Nand Kishor Gupta (46), breathed his last yesterday in Mumbai was laid to rest today ([10](#) June) after necessary rituals. Mortal remains of Gupta were taken to Guwahati by a morning flight and he was paid last tribute by the members of Guwahati Press Club on way to his [city](#) residence.

The soft spoken journalist was suffering from gallbladder [cancer](#) and referred to Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai for his treatment. He went there on 3 June last. Gupta, who worked with various Hindi dailies including Hindi Sentinel, Pratah Khabar and Purvanchal Prahari left behind his mother, wife, a daughter, a minor son besides a host of relatives. Till the time of his death, Gupta was associated with Purvanchal Prahari [as](#) a senior sub editor.
