

Guwahati businessmen kidnapped

After a lull insurgent outfits resume kidnapping and extortion in Guwahati. Suspected ULFA militants kidnapped two businessmen from city on Saturday night. According to information, a dairy firm owner Bishnu Kedia and his brother in law Sanjoy Agarwal have gone missing since Saturday midnight on their way from Fancy Bazar to Narengi. Their mobile phones are remaining switch-off. Ten hours after police registered the complaint the vehicle was found at Narengi on Sunday. Nobody has claimed the responsibility of the case. But in view of ULFA's intensified extortion drive it may be a handiwork of ULFA. In the same breath, NDFB's role can't be ruled out. Rescue operation is on.
