

Half citizens in Arunachal to come to Assam!



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Prabajan Virodhi Manch, a social organization against the immigration issue, has raised serious concern [over](#) the Centre's decision to [grant](#) citizenship to the [Chakma](#) and Hajong [refugees](#) in [Arunachal](#) Pradesh.

The convener of the organization Upomanyu [Hazarika](#) said on Saturday that finally, these [refugees](#) would come to Assam since [Arunachal](#) Pradesh has announced no land [rights](#) to these people who migrated from the Chittagang Hills Tracks.

He appreciated the [Arunachal](#) Pradesh leadership for half citizenship formula to these [Chakma](#) and Hajong [refugees](#) after the Supreme court asked the Centre to [grant](#) them citizenship triggering massive protest across the north eastern [state](#).

[Hazarika](#), who is a senior lawyer said why the leadership has not been taking any lesson from the [Arunachal](#) Pradesh counterpart as it has been grappling with the Bangladeshi immigrants issue.

The Supreme Court very recently asked the Centre to [grant](#) citizenship to the [Chakma](#) and Hajong [refugees](#) much to the major concern for the people who have been dead opposed to the idea and the [state](#) leadership has prevailed upon the formula of half citizenship where these new citizens would not have the land [rights](#).

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
