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A hardcore ULFA cadre Pipla Moran was reportedly killed during an encounter with army this evening at Teji Jingoni village in Tinsukia district. But the Army's 7/11 Gorkha Regiment, which is running the crackdown has yet to confirm it. In yet another operation, Army's 11th Sikhli Regiment has busted an ULFA camp at Lalpahar area in the forest areas in Arunachal Pradesh. The camp has a few bunker but no arms and ammunition have been found during the operation.
