

HC to take Paul's bail plea on Friday



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GUWAHATI: The Gauhati High Court will hear Rakesh [Paul](#)'s bail plea on Friday since the government has yet to submit the affidavit for hearing on Wednesday.

A division bench of the court which took up the bail plea of the arrested APSC chairman asked the authority to ensure the submission by Thursday.

[Paul](#) has been remanded to jail in a graft case pending with Bhangagarh police station where he allegedly demanded bribe from a candidate of an APSC interview.

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
