

Hepatitis-B camp at press club



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The second dose of Hepatitis-B vaccine, who took the first dose of vaccine at Guwahati Press Club last month, will be administered tomorrow ([7 May 2016](#)) at the same venue. The vaccination camp, organized by the [city](#) based Dispur Hospitals, will [start](#) at 11 am and conclude by 1 pm.

It may be mentioned that Dispur Hospitals private limited organized a special health camp and Hepatitis-B vaccination program for the lady journalists and better-halves of male scribes at press club on the eve of International Women's Day.
