Caught in a barrage of criticism, prime minister [Narendra Modi](#) is on a day long visit to Assam to take stock of the flood fury after the [state](#) counts nearly 80 people dead.

According to sources in [New Delhi](#), the prime minister is arriving in Guwahati at [10](#) in the morning and is scheduled to make an aerial survey in Lakhimpur and other worst-hit districts where properties worth several crores were ravaged.

Chief minister Sarbananda Sonowal and senior colleague Himanta Biswa Sarma are also accompanying Modi in the day long programme.

Modi drew flak across the [state](#) for failing to reach the marooned people forcing him to suddenly finalise his visit to Assam where lakhs of people in 15 districts are still feeling under the first wave of flood.
