

Hindi-speaking workers hurt in firing

Two persons have been injured when unidentified [gunmen](#) attacked a [group](#) of [workers](#) at a stone crushing site in Dibrugarh district bordering [Arunachal](#) Pradesh on Monday.

According to the eyewitnesses, the incident took place in Namrup along the Sivasagar-Dibrugarh districts at 7-50 in the evening when the [workers](#) were preparing to leave for homes.

Suddenly, two motor cycle born [gunmen](#) halted and fired upon the [workers](#) where Sanjay Bharatiya and Gopal Shah fell injured. Then the [gunmen](#) vanished from the spot.

The injured were rushed to the Assam Medical College Hospital in critical condition. Policemen have cordoned off the area in search of the militants. No outfit has so far claimed the responsibility. It is suspected to be a handiwork of [ULFA](#)-I.

But [NSCN](#)-K's role cannot be ruled out [as](#) the area bordering [Arunachal Pradesh](#) has been a safe haven for the [ULFA](#)-I, [NSCN](#)-K militants.

The incident took place hours after Kahgen Sarma handed [over](#) charge to Mukesh Sahay [as](#) director general of police.
