

Hit and run claims one on NH 37 at Phulaguri

A 16-year-old boy named Abhinash nath, crossing the NH 37 near Phulaguri in the Nagaon district died at the scene after being hit by an unknown [vehicle](#) (suspected to be a Swift dzire) on Saturday morning. According to locals, Abinash nath, son of Mohan nath of Pahupurikhaiti under Raha police station was a Class [X student](#) of Phulaguri Sankardev Sishu vidya niketan. [Eye](#) Witness said, the tregedy struck Abhinash while crossing the NH37 with earphones plugged in. He was on his way to his tuition classes riding his bycycle in the morning. Meanwhile, the Raha police are still trying to locate the Vehicle that was responsible for the accident and had fled from the scene.
