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GUWAHATI: Assam Times [Journalist](#) and conservation activist Mubina Akhtar received the award of Excellence in Journalism, 2018 for her relentless contribution to the field of Environmental Reporting from the State [Social](#) Justice Commission at a function in the city organized to mark the International Women's Day.

Ten women from the [state](#) were awarded for their contributions in their respective fields. The award comprised a citation, a memento, phoolam gamocha and a japi.
