

Hope end to NHPC impasse: Goel



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The [Centre](#) is hopeful. It wants an [end](#) to the three year long impasse over the [NHPC](#)-owned power project in Gerukamukh along the [Assam](#)-Aunachal Pradesh [border](#).

Addressing a function in New Delhi on Tuesday, Union power minister Piyush [Goel](#) said that he was hopeful to resolve the dispute between Arunachal Pradesh and [Assam](#) over the Lower Subansiri Hydro [Power](#) Project by next month.

He said, “we are looking to resolve the dispute by next month after calling officials from [Assam](#).”

Developed by [NHPC](#), cost of the project cost has gone up by about ₹1,200 crore due to forced [suspension](#) of work since December 2011. The company has already spent ₹6,600 crore.
