

Hospital without doctor

In yet another sordid tale of the government's utter negligence towards the rural health sector, the Dakua Mini PHC at Purandia of [Udalguri](#) district, which was established way back in 1975, lacks proper infrastructure and staff.

The mini health care centre located at a distance of [10](#) km from [Tangla](#) town is the lifeline for the people of the Dewar, Khokabasti, Tetelichuba, Kaulibhanga, Hahini, Majgaon, Gerua, Purandia, Bangaon villages facing a tough time in getting medical treatment who needs to visit nearby towns for treatment.

The mini PHC is currently functioning with a Homoeopathic doctor Dr. Utpal Sarmah who officially needs to visits the centre twice a week while he allegedly visits once a week. Only oe pharmacist Bhaskar Jyoti Sarmah and a 4th grade employee Nagendra Kr. Nath regularly turns up in the centre for treating patients numbering 20-30 daily.

The doctor's post is still lying vacant since April [2016](#).
