In the interest of the Hmar community of Assam and towards the prevailing in Assam the Hmar peoples' Convention (democratic) of Assam declares unilateral ceasefire with Central Government, State Government and Security forces on Friday Mr David L. Hmar, Information and Publicity officer, HPC(D) disclosed in press meet held somewhere in Borail hill that they would be approaching the Government for a formal for finding a permanent and respectable solution for the Hmar community in Assam.
