

## HSLC exams begin



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Over 2,83,000 candidates are appearing for the High School Leaving Certificate Examination and High Madrassa examination on Thursday.

The examination has begun at 9 in the morning at altogether 833 centres across the state. The state board of secondary examination which conducts the examination has deployed over 2500 officials to ensure free and fair examination this time.
