

## Huge blockade hits transport

A huge road blockade on a vital road in the outskirts of Guwahati heavily disrupted transport services on Saturday.

Thousands of people in Kukurmora area near Boko blocked the [National Highway No 37](#) a day after the Sarbananda Sonowal Government rejected erstwhile Gogoi Government's move to create the South Kamrup district.

Trucks, buses along with other two and four wheelers on the road were forced to remain standstill for several hours [as](#) the protesters refused to disperse from [10](#) in the morning.

A crucial cabinet meeting on Friday evening abandoned the idea of creating East and South Kamrup districts considering the lack of adequate infrastructure much to the major disappointment of the people.

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## Nazira tension persists after youth leader's killing; police probe alleged drug network

**NAZIRA, September 27, 2026** — Tension continues to prevail in Nazira, particularly in the Santak-Bihubar area, following the killing of Biman Barua, president of the Rangajan Yuva Samaj and a youth social worker, on September 18 under Bihubar Police Station.

Following the killing, local residents have been demanding stringent punishment for the alleged masterminds, Ravindra Singh alias Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan, besides seeking demolition of Vicky Singh's residence.

Meanwhile, Sivasagar district police have taken Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan into custody and are questioning them at the district headquarters police station in connection with the murder case and allegations of drug-related activities.

According to police sources, the two allegedly told investigators during questioning that drugs were brought from Dimapur and Nagaland and stored at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister in Nazira town. The drugs were allegedly supplied from the house to users in different parts of Nazira and Sivasagar.

Based on the information allegedly obtained during the questioning, a joint team of Bihubar Police and Nazira Model Police Station conducted a raid at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister, Rinki Singh Bora, in Ward No. 6 of Nazira town on Saturday morning.

Police detained Rinki Singh Bora and are reportedly questioning her in connection with the alleged storage and distribution of drugs.

The investigation into the murder of Biman Barua and the alleged drug network is continuing.
