

I am not aware of PM directive to Razi: Gogoi

Amidst the report of a simmering tension at the Raj Bhawan following reports of PM's directive to Governor Syed Sibtey Razi to quit, Assam Chief Minister Tarun Gogoi said he was not aware of any development in this regard.

Talking to reporters in Delhi on Tuesday after his meeting with UPA chief Sonia Gandhi, Gogoi said there as no complaint against Razi in Assam and that h did not opposed when he Razi was posted in Assam. Gogoi called on Sonia Gandhi and apprised her of the state's overall situation.

In yet another development, the prime minister's office has denied any report of PM's instruction for Razi to quit the office immediately. Senior Congress leaders in Delhi also dismissed the media report.
