

Illegal saw mill seized



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Acting on a tip-off a team of forest officials of Dhansiri Forest Division and 37 Bn SSB seized a saw machine and cache of valuable timber logs at Jhargaon near Khoirabari of [Udalguri](#) district on Saturday. Reportedly in a joint hunt of Dhansiri Forest Division of Nonai Range and another troop of 37 Bn SSB seized 1.447 cm valuable timber from a illegal mill and also seized two another saw machine and a little cache of timber from two different illegal mills."
