MARGHERITA: The Police have detained more than a dozen illegal Bangladeshi settlers in Margherita on Thursday.

Margherita unit of [AJYCP leaders](#) and activists who spotted them loitering on the bank of the river Burhidihing and after questioning them police men came and took them in detention.

Talking to Assam Times, local [AJYCP leaders](#) said for the last several months they have been working at a nearby brick kiln staying in some [huts](#). Now [AJYCP workers](#) are looking for some other settlers in the area. When police questioned them they have failed to give any convincing reply.
