

Inferno gutts shops at Dimakuchi



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A ravaging [inferno](#) gutted at least five shops near [Dimakuchi](#) police station of [Udalguri](#) district. Fire broke out at about 11.30 pm on Friday night. The fire [soon](#) spread to a few shops located nearby. Fire-fighters had a tough time [as](#) they battled flames before finally succeeding in dousing the blaze. The reason for the blaze is suspected to be from a [shop](#) which stocked nearly 150 litres of petrol. Property worth more than [ten](#) lakhs were gutted in the flames. Reportedly the locals damaged the fire-fighting vehicles of Khoirabari fire station which allegedly arrive late. [Dimakuchi](#) police have lodged an F.I.R [against](#) three unknown miscreants for damaging the [vehicle](#) .
