

Injured wild pachyderm remains in agony



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The [Udalguri](#) district which is infamous and in headlines in recent times for the highest casualties in Asia resulting in the Man-[Elephant](#) conflict has another wild jumbo separated from a herd which sustained injury and has been writhing in pain in a drain at Ganesh Ghat of Majuli Basti under Harisinga PS neighbouring the Indo-Bhutan area. The [elephant](#) with a head injury had been in the [waters](#) wallowing in its waste [as](#) it waits for its rescue since Wednesday night.

Pertinently the local villagers alleged that though they repeatedly informed forest officials for the rescue of the jumbo no forest officials or Veterinary team reached the spot till the filing of this report. The local media persons also made efforts to inform the forest officials but to no help.
