The Indigenous Peoples' Forum (IPF) hereby liked to clarify on the statement telecast in the NE TV, reported on 12th Sept. 2011 about the alleged nexus between the NSCN (IM) and the IPF stated in a press release On September 14 signed by Secretary Inf. & Publicity

In the statement, it has been alleged that the IPF had been formed under the guidance of the NSCN (IM).
