Two persons were apprehended for involved with poaching under Bhuyanpara forest range in Manash [National](#) Park in Baksa on Tuesday.

According to forest official, a joint team of forest staff from Bhuyanpara range and Salbari police conducted a search operation in Rupohi area where two poachers were arrested along with a piece of ivory. The recovered tuskers' weight was around one kg and its market value was around one lakh. They were identified [as](#) Bulang Kherkatary and Rudang Basumatary, who were involved with poaching inside MNP.

'The forest staff and police have been raided [against](#) poaching in the area to protect Manash [National](#) Park and successfully apprehend poachers', said a senior forest officer in Bhuyanpara range.
