

Jail for accused ACS officer



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GUWAHATI: Nishamoni Deka, an accused ACS officer in the APSC scam has been sent to judicial custody on Tuesday after the end of police custody for the ACS officer involved in the APSC scam.

After the end of her 14 days remand police did not seek her in their remand again.

Deka went underground hours after the police [launched](#) the massive crackdown against the accused ACS, APS and allied service officers in November.

Later she surrendered before the police who got her in their remand for 14 days.

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
