

Journalist Jaiklong Brahma arrested

Jaiklong [Brahma](#), a senior journalist in [Kokrajhar](#), was arrested by [police](#) on [Tuesday](#) night in [Kokrajhar](#) for links with NDFB (Songbijit faction). [Brahma](#), who is currently working as Correspondent with a [Guwahati](#) based satellite television channel. [Brahma](#) was called by [police](#) for personal discussion at [Kokrajhar](#) Sadar [police](#) station, but later arrested.

Sunil Kumar, [SP Kokrajhar](#) said that [Brahma](#) was arrested for allegedly voluntarily inciting the banned terrorist organization for committing violence since last few months. He said that he was arrested under a case at [Kokrajhar police](#) station no.367/14,U/S 120(B)/121/121(A) 109 IPC R/W sec 10/13(B)/18 UAP (Amendment) Act 2008.

[Brahma](#) was was produced before court on Wednesday.

[Media](#) fraternity and family members protested the arrest and demanded unconditional release of [Brahma](#).
