

JP Nadda suspends Guwahati visit



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Guwahati: BJP president JP Nadda has deferred his two days visit to Guwahati on Thursday and Friday in view of the demise of former Chief Minister Tarun Gogoi. According to state party leaders, Nadda will let the state BJP leadership know his rescheduled date very soon.

Accompanied by central party observer Baijayant Jai Panda, JP Nadda was scheduled to arrive in Guwahati on Thursday to hold at least 14 party meeting ahead of 2021 assembly polls. But Gogoi's sudden demise has disrupted the scheduled.

The party also suspended all activities and announced three state mourning.

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
