

Judicial custody for ONGC GM



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A CBI special court in Guwahati on Wednesday sent PK Bora to judicial custody for 14 days a day after the ONGC general manager was arrested for taking a bribe of Rs 40,000 from a contractor. CBI sought Bora in its custody when they produced him before the court on Wednesday. But the court remanded him to judicial custody for 14 days. A case has been registered under the Prevention of Corruption Act. He was arrested Tuesday from his office in Sivasagar district while accepting the bribe.
