

Jyotirmoy Guwahati police commissioner

After months of will-it-won't-it, the Assam government has announced police commissionerate on Tuesday. The machinery would come in to force from Thursday.

Police Commissioner is Jyotirmoy Chakrabarti while ANM Haque is joint police commissioner. The Guwahati police commissionerate would have four deputy police commissioner.

Hemanta [Das](#) will look into the east side while Amitabh Sinha will be in the charge of the central part. DCP for west side of the [city](#) is Jitmol Doley while Pranabjyoti Goswami has been appointed as DCP for traffic.

The government has further announced five SPs for five new police districts. According to a notification, Longnit Teron will be SP for Majuli while his counterpart for Biswanath Chariali is Manabendra Deb [Roy](#). Kangkanjyoti Saikia has been posted as Hojai SP while South Salmara SP is Mihirjit Gayan. Sudhakar Singh is SP for Sadiya.

KOKRAJHAR, September 22, 2026 — The All Bodo Students' Union (ABSU) on Tuesday burnt copies of a book titled *Hamkoshar Parishista* during protests held at several locations across Assam, including Gauhati University, objecting to what it described as the use of the Assamese script to represent the Bodo language.

Hamkoshar Parishista is a multilingual appendix containing learning resources for indigenous languages of Assam, including Bodo, Rabha, Mising and Karbi.

During the protests, ABSU members alleged that Bodo has been represented in the publication using the Assamese script instead of Devanagari, the script used for Bodo.

The organisation asserted that Bodo is recognised under the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution of India and is an Associate Official Language of Assam. ABSU demanded that Bodo be represented in its recognised script in educational and learning resources.

ABSU president Khwrmmdao Wary said the use of the Assamese script to represent Bodo in the publication was disrespectful to the Bodo language and literature.

He said Bodo is an Associate Official Language of Assam and a language recognised under the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution.

Wary demanded the immediate withdrawal of the publication in its present form and called for the use of the Devanagari script for Bodo in the book.



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
