

Kaushik's dream run end in semis



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A dream run in the Indian Oil ITF World Junior Ranking Tennis Championship finally came to an end for Kaushik Das as he today lost the boys singles semi final against Lewicki Filip of Poland at the Chachal tennis court on Thursday. The Assam lad was in his best form in the tournament and even in the semi final too he played superbly but Filip finally managed to over come the challenge of Das. Filip won the match by 6-3, 2-6, 6-3 to move into the final where he will meet Adil Hakim of Australia.

In the girls final Angelica Aleiv of Israel will play against Alieva Sevil of

Azerbaijan.
