

Kha Yurna Mataimei premiered



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On April 1 and [2](#), the typically cold and [dark](#) Ukhul nights with cloudy drizzling skies, came alive for a worthy reason. Those were the glamorous nights when the red carpet premiere show -- a first of its kind in the district -- of the highly-anticipated new Tangkhul feature film 'Kha Yurna Mataimei' turned the usual plain humdrum Town Hall into a perfect milieu for the two-day premiere extravaganza.
