

Kisan Satyagraha at Kokrajhar

Thousands of activists from Youth [Congress](#) and partyment participated at the Kisan [Satyagraha](#) in protest [against](#) new Land Acquisition ordinance 2014 initiative by BJP led NDA government, organised by Kokrajhar Lok Sabha Youth [Congress](#) committee todatt at Pragati Bhawan in Kokrajhar.

The activists with banner, festoon and placards shouted slogans BJP govt hai hai, stop new land acquisition ordinance and held good governance across the country which was started from [10](#) Am to 1 PM. The satyagraha submitted a memorandum to President of India through Kokrajhar DC in protest [against](#) anti-farmer amendments in Land acquisition ordinance 2014.

Sambhu Mandal, president of Kokrajhar Lok Sabha Youth [Congress](#) committee participating the satyagraha said that the BJP led NDA government has been taking anti-farmer stand since after assumed power at the centre there seems a deliberate attempt to harm agriculture industry, especially the small farmers and agriculture based workers. He said that farmers are not getting fair [price](#) for their production, the benefits of drop in diesel prices are not reaching to the domestic consumers most affected by which are small farmers again and there is a shortage of fertilizers, urea and seed varieties. He has alleged that BJP led NDA government is trying to snatch farmers' and tribals' land on the name of land reforms across the country.

Mandal demanded stop of new land acquisition ordinance 2014 and make peoples [welfare](#) across the country against existing land policy.
