

Lead to triple murder mystery!



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The DNA report of a decomposed body is expected to crack the Banphool murder mystery. River police on the [Brahmaputra](#) recovered a decomposed body on Wednesday.

It was widely believed to be of Pranab Mahanta who went missing after allegedly killing his wife along with two daughters inside his residence.

After sending the body for DNA test, police officials probing the triple murder case are waiting for confirmation.
