A team of enforcement directorate on Wednesday visited the Dispur police station and collected papers and complaints of the multi crore scam that rocks the state.

Chief minister [Tarun Gogoi](#) has already asked an administrative enquiry by SC [Das](#) to find out the prima facie evidence before recommending a CBI probe.
