

Major blast averted in Rangiya as explosive materials recovered



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A major blast was averted in Rangiya on Tuesday when police and CRPF recovered a huge cache of explosive materials from the Rangiya bus station and picked up three people in this connection. According to information, these explosive materials including 30 grenades, 30 detonators have been found from a bus bearing No AS 21-0441 at the Rangia Bus station.
