Massive protest hits in Tinsukia district over allegations of fake encounter where security forces claimed to have killed a youth. With banners and festooned the local residents demanded action against the security forces who shot dead the innocent youth in the name of encounter with ULFA. Citing the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, Ulfa he said that extra judicial killings, fake encounters and sexual harassment in Assam are always being carried out to suppress the voice of protest.
