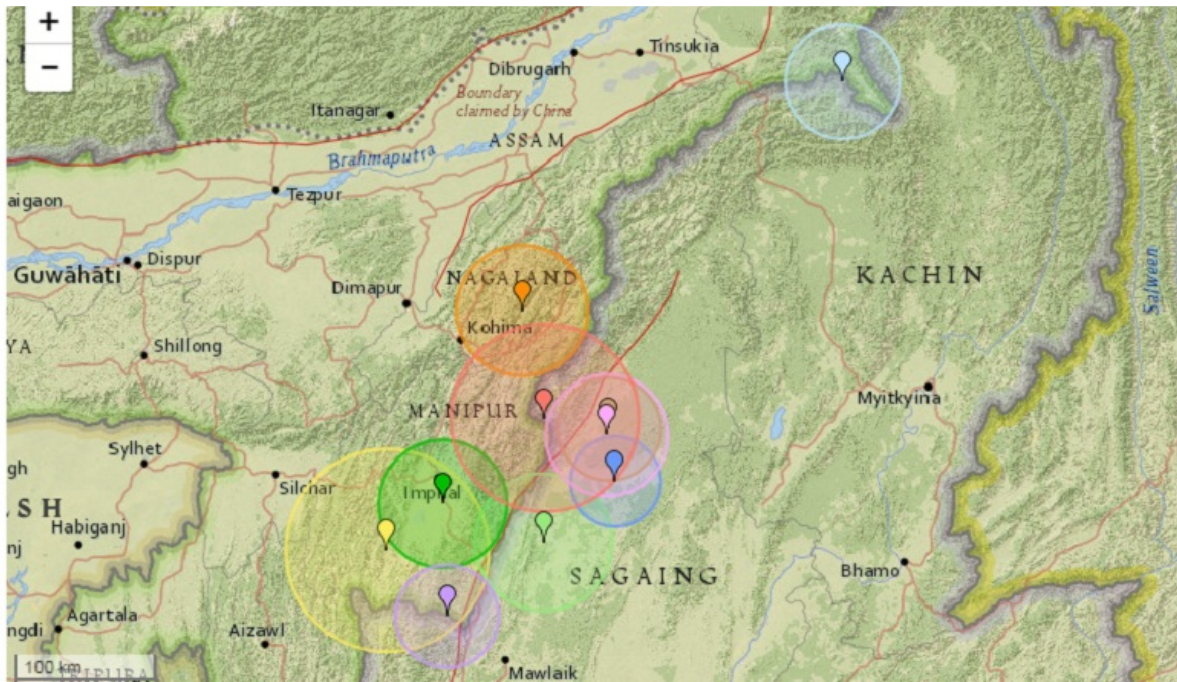


Mild quake shakes Nagaland
